• Students enrolled full time (nine or more credit hours) will receive \$1000.00 with proof of registration, social security card, proper identification and signature on Holy Helping Hands Receipt of Scholarship Funds.

For four-year colleges:

- Students enrolled full time (nine or more credit hours) will receive \$1000.00 scholarship with proof of registration, proper identification and signature on *Holy Helping Hands Receipt of Scholarship Funds*.
- Students must provide college acceptance letters.
