- ❖ L.A. County Resident
- ❖ Ages:
  - 14-24, *OR*
  - 16-18 *AND* Receiving CalWORKS
  - (19 years old must be in CalLearn program), *OR*
  - 14-21 *AND* Current Foster Youth
- ❖ Have a right to work in U.S.
- ❖ Must have a work permit, if under 18

### Program Benefits:

- ❖ Up to 180 hours PAID work experience, including up to 20 hours of training
- ❖ Year-round work experience, if eligible
- ❖ Entry level positions
- ❖ Earn the minimum wage
- ❖ Work for a variety of Employers in private, public, or non-profit sectors
- ❖ Get noticed by the Employers for possible hiring

\*There may be other eligibility requirements, depending on program funding.
