- Supplies, including scan tron forms, paper, writing materials, calculators, and other materials necessary for classes

### To receive this scholarship award, you must fulfill certain requirements, including:

- Enrolling in Santiago Canyon College's online WUS program and taking the following classes:
  - Water 050 - Water Mathematics and Hydraulics
  - Water 061 - Water Distribution
- Completing the WUS coursework with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above, and applying for Water Distribution Grade 2 certification testing

The courses that must be taken are 3 credits each. After they are completed, these credits can be used if you want to continue your education.
