

Surveyors' Union Open for Testing

If you have candidates interested in becoming a union surveyor, have them go to <https://scsurveyjac.org/> to sign up to take the test. Deadline to apply is February 28th. Don't wait though because scheduling for the test is first come first served.

Starting pay is around \$16 with excellent benefits and quickly increases to around \$30/hr for basic surveyor (specializing increases pay). Historically testing has been every 2 years, so please don't wait to sign up.

Program Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be in good health and physically able to perform all phases of the work.
- May be subject to drug testing prior to being eligible for employment.
- Must be able to read, write, and speak the English language.
- Must complete an application form containing a complete school record and previous work experience.
- Must show proof of high school graduation or GED.
- Must produce documentation of eligibility for employment in the United States.
- Must know algebra and geometry sufficient to obtain a satisfactory score (75% or higher) on the Surveyors Joint Apprenticeship Qualification Test.

- Layout high-rise buildings, roads and freeways, residential developments, dams, waterways, pipelines, airports, tunnels, and commercial & industrial developments.
- Do specialized work, Boundaries, ALTA/ACSM Land Title Surveys, Deformation Surveys, Hydrographic Surveys.
- Perform Inspections and As-Built Surveys, Topographic Surveys.
- Work with Global Positioning Systems (GPS) Scanners, Drones, Robotic Instruments and Computers.
