The Opportunity Scholars Public Health Academy (PHA) is a year-long academic enrichment program for 10th and 11th grade students interested in improving community health through a career in public health. PHA was developed to establish a unique educational experience to prepare students for success in college. The program takes place Tuesday through Saturday from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. **July 9-August 3, 2019**. Summer learning focuses on mental health, public health, SAT preparation, college preparation, math enrichment, Rites of passage, medical college lectures, guest speakers and more.

Students who successfully complete the summer component and have perfect attendance in the program will receive a \$1,000 stipend. During the School year students work with a mentor and are required to complete a paid internship where they align classroom learning to real world experience.
