VITAL DOCUMENTS INFORMATION

ACHSA will be offering FREE certified birth certificates and replacement Social Security cards at the Countywide Youth Resource Fair on July 16, 2019, from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the California Endowment. If you are interested in applying for one or both of these, you will need to bring certain items. Please read the instructions below:

Birth Certificate:

A birth certificate can be used to prove your identity and to get a passport. You can request a birth certificate at the fair if you were born in Los Angeles County. If you were born outside of Los Angeles County, you will not be able to request a birth certificate at the fair.

To get a birth certificate, you will need to:

- Complete an application with the applicant's full name, birth date, and your relationship to the person
- Sign a penalty of perjury statement

Social Security Card:

A Social Security number is used to get a job, collect Social Security benefits, and receive other government services (although you do not usually need to show your Social Security card).

To get a Social Security card, you will need to:

- Complete and sign an application with the applicant's full name, birth date, place of birth, and contact information
- Show the applicant's school photo ID, California ID, or health insurance card
