Step I: Complete FSA ID <u>(Video Link Here)</u>

Step II: Use an email that the youth will check on a regular basis.

Step III: Ensure that the youth has their Social Security number and their FSA ID matches their name on their SSN Card.

Senior Expenses Application Process What is needed?

ATTENTION BOTH APPLICATIONS DUE 3/31/2025

Submit your completed ILP packets to your ILP team:

Senior packets include:

- ILP Request Letter signed by youth. Current TILP (01/23) signed by youth, caregiver, CSW & SCSW.
- **Senior Expense Application- School** counselor should complete and sign the form with the school seal or stamp. **Unofficial Transcript**

Working with the High School Senior on your caseload



Conversations should go something like this...

- 1. What is your plan after high school?
- 2. Do you have your CA ID, Birth Certificate & Social Security Card?
- 3. Are you meeting with your high school counselor to make sure you are on track to graduate? (Follow-up with an email to youth's counselor)



Are back reach out to your ILP Team to find one near you!

REAL ID DEADLINE 5/7/25 - MORE LOCATIONS COMING SOON!



- To apply for a real ID you will need the following:
- Proof of ID (original birth certificate)
- Proof of Residency (bill, bank statement, school records)
- Agency-Group Home Agreement, Placement Agency Foster Family Agreement, Foster-Parent Agreement
- Social Security Card or the number

WHAT ARE VITAL DOCS?

- Birth Certificate Required to get a CA REAL ID, social security card, and to prove their identity.

 Social Security Card A Social Security Card is needed to obtain a job and other services. It should be kept in safe place.
- California REAL ID* Issued at any age. The ID card is needed to prove identify. Ask your ILPC for the Reduced Fee Waiver form.

HOUSING RESOURCES FROM SUPPORTIVE HOUSING DIVISION

SHD has housing resources to support TAY becoming Independent.

- Open Cases & Exiting Youth: THPP-NMD, Bridge Housing, TLS Closed Cases (ages 18-25; 18-20): THP Plus, ILP THP
- Open Cases with Children: Bringing Families Home (BFH)

- **Application**
- 2.8 GPA or higher in A-G requirements (weighted)
- **Enrolled into to a Community College or University for Fall** 2025 as a full time student *proof of enrollment is required to receive scholarship
- Personal Statement/Essay
- Unofficial transcript

- Minimum 2.0 GPA (weighted) in A-G requirements (If applying for Scholarship)
- Enrolled into a Vocational Program, Community College or University for Fall 2025 as a full time student (If applying for scholarship) *proof of enrollment is required to receive scholarship
- Personal Statement/Essay (If applying for scholarship)
